► What

- collaboration
- ASCD has not had an ^{EL} issue about collaboration since 1986 — was really more about partnerships.
 - Even recent ~~collabor~~ assessment books do not have much about collaboration
 - "Ahead of the Curve" ← check this out
 - Assessment as ongoing (not standardized testing)

► Why

- collaboration + assessment are more powerful together than alone
- having a "push-in" service program has helped to facilitate collaboration

▶ How

- ▶ Create Google Docs — helps track info to aid instructional decisions
 - ▶ some info is observational ... some is evaluative — ^{*}this is an interesting contrast with session 1102^{*}
 - ▶ can be used as a running record for individual student
 - ▶ information could be passed along to next grade level
- ▶ Sharing is powerful for teachers — can be professional development for teachers as they read comments
- ▶ Spreadsheets are ~~a~~ easy to update throughout the year
